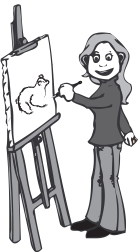
In The Shadow of Bears - Yoga and Meditation — *June 19th and Aug. 7th*

Find your inner doorway to the natural rhythms of nature by practicing yoga and meditation and becoming one within the shadows of the normally reclusive black bear. Surround yourself with the bears and awaken your senses, enhance your focus and reconnect to the natural world.



Spend a Night Surrounded by Bears Camping — *June 28-29th*

What goes bump in the night? Find out by spending a night at the Vince Shute Wildlife Sanctuary surrounded by black bears. Experience what it is like to camp with bears from the safety of our viewing platform. This is an excellent opportunity to view the bears nocturnal habits while learning about bear behavior and safety. Learn what it takes to camp in bear country and take these precautions home with you to practice on your own.



Bears in Figure and Form Drawing Class — *July 12th and Aug. 23rd*
